

#### Dear Parents,

I pray you and your family are well. As Catholic Schools Week approaches, we would like to reflect on the Archdiocese of Miami's theme for this year: Faith to Move Mountains. Our Catholic school strives for excellence, not only for academic success, but also for the spiritual development of our children. We keep our faith at the forefront of everything we do at Mother of Christ. As it gives us the strength to accomplish anything.

I would like to highlight some of our accomplishments thus far this school year:

- Our school and learning center's enrollment this past school year increased by more than 10%. Some of our classes have waiting lists, so register soon!!!
- We participated in the Christopher Columbus and St. Brendan Academic Olympics. Combined, we won 7 gold, 10 silver and 4 bronze medals.
- Our Varsity Volleyball team won the overall CHAMPIONSHIP for our division.
- Our 8th graders tested for the Catholic high schools in December. Let us keep them in our prayers as they are awaiting their results this coming week.
- We completed several social justice projects such as raising money for ADOM's Baby Bottle Campaign for Respect Life to support pregnant mothers, as well as a Christmas collection of clothes and toys for less fortunate children. As we prepare for the 2024-2025 school year, you will find attached all the information needed to re-register your child. Please make sure that you read all the information carefully and follow the appropriate dates to ensure a seamless process.

We have separated all costs into two categories: Registration & Tuition. On the attached sheet you will see that the Safety and Activity fees have been incorporated into the Tuition category. Registration has been lowered to \$375.00 and must be paid by March 15th in order to secure your child's placement.

After budgetary recommendations from the Finance Committee and review from the School Advisory Committee, an adjustment has been made to the tuition rate this year. This decision was made after careful consideration and thorough analysis of our academic programs and overall learning environment. The increase is essential to maintain and enhance the educational experience that we strive to provide for your child. Mother of Christ will continue to accept Step Up for Students and other state scholarships to assist families. Families currently enrolled at Mother of Christ must register for the next academic year by February 1st. Tuition rates and the registration fee for the 2024-2025 school year are attached.

All current 2023-24 school year financial obligations must be current before registration will be accepted for the new 2024-25 school year.

# GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025

Non-Refundable Registration Fee: \$375.00 per child May be paid in 3 payments of \$125.00 each by March 15<sup>th</sup>

## **Tuition:**

Kinder - Grade 5: \$8,425.00 per child Grades 6-8: \$8,525.00 per child

### **Tuition Includes:**

Activity Fee Counseling Services Insurance
Instructional Materials Safety Fee Yearbook
Standardized Testing Technology Fee S.T.E.M. Materials
Textbooks/Workbooks Digital Instructional Programs

Tuition balance will be paid in 10 monthly payments from August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024 – May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

## Fees that may apply that are not included in tuition:

Field Trips, Lunch, Graduation, Sacramental, After School Care, Extracurricular Activities, Sports Teams, and other miscellaneous activities.

Active parishioners of the Church who participate in the faith life of the parish by giving fully of their time, talent, and by regularly attending Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation who have multiple children registered in the school may be eligible for a discretionary tuition assistance.
